## WKU allows seniors to self-report GPA

Western Kentucky University is allowing high school seniors to self-report their GPA to keep the admissions process on track.

Nontraditional students wishing to pursue a WKU degree in response to the current economic climate can also self-report their GPA to begin the admissions process while seeking their official transcripts.

The Office of Student Financial Assistance will use the information to issue estimated scholarship awards. New first-time freshmen have access to expanded scholarship opportunities for those with at least a 3.0 high school GPA.
