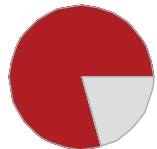




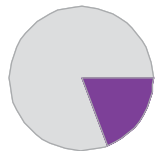

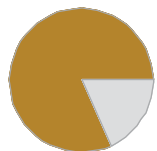
## College of Health and Human Services Student Profile Fall 2017 - 2021



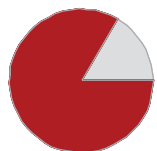
In Health and Human Services, **females** make up **80%** of the student population.
