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## NAME CHANGE TO DEPARTMENT OF SOCIOLOGY AND CRIMINOLOGY

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**REQUEST:** Approval to change the name of the Department of Sociology within Potter College of Arts and Letters to the Department of Sociology and Criminology.

**FACTS:** The Department of Sociology has offered a Criminology minor since 1986, a Master of Arts in Criminology since 2009, and a Bachelor of Arts in Criminology since 2014. WKU is the only public university in the state to offer B.A. and M.A. Criminology degrees (Morehead State offers a B.A. in Criminology and Criminal Justice; all other public universities that offer degree programs in this area offer Criminal Justice B.A. degrees). Since their inception at WKU, each program has seen steady and robust enrollment growth. At present 323 students have declared an undergraduate major in Criminology. In addition, the Criminology M.A. program, which is online, has consistently been ranked in the top 20 of crime-related online masters programs around the country. Specifically, “CollegeChoice.net” ranked the program #5 in 2018 for “Best Online Master’s in Criminology Degrees,” “Best Colleges.com” ranked the program #10, and “US News and World Report” currently ranks the program at #16. The website “onlinemasters.com” recently featured the WKU Criminology MA as “One of the Best Master’s in Criminology” programs in America.

The departmental faculty recognizes the growth of these programs and wishes to highlight them by including Criminology in the name of the department. Among the benefits to students, faculty, and the university from the desired name change would be:

- To provide a clear indication of where the Criminology program resides. For example, signage and form changes (i.e., letterhead and brochures) should make it easier for individuals both on and off campus to find program faculty and advisors.
- To increase online visibility of WKU Criminology programs for prospective students. A change to the department’s web and social media presence—departmental website, Facebook, and Twitter accounts—would better advertise the Criminology programs.

On August 16, 2017, the department faculty members voted unanimously to change the department’s name to the “Department of Sociology and Criminology.”

**BUDGETARY IMPLICATIONS:** This requested name change will not have a significant budgetary impact.

**RECOMMENDATION:** President Timothy C. Caboni recommends the name be changed from the Department of Sociology to the Department of Sociology and Criminology within Potter College of Arts and Letters, effective July 1, 2019.

**MOTION:** Approval to change the Department of Sociology within Potter College of Arts and Letters to the Department of Sociology and Criminology.

**CONSOLIDATION OF THREE UNITS WITHIN THE COLLEGE OF HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES**

**REQUEST:** Approval to consolidate the Department of Allied Health, the Institute for Rural Health and the School of Nursing into a new unit to be titled the School of Nursing and Allied Health within the College of Health and Human Services.

**FACTS:**

- In the past, the Department of Allied Health housed several programs, including the Baccalaureate of Health Sciences, Baccalaureate in Health Information Management, Paramedicine (AAS), and Dental Hygiene (AS and BS). However, in 2016, the Health Sciences and Health Information Management Programs were moved to the department of Public Health, and the Paramedicine program was suspended due to resource and enrollment issues. At present, the only programs remaining within the Department of Allied Health are the Dental Hygiene Programs (AS and BS), with most of the students seeking admission to the BS program.

- Dental Hygiene is not currently available from the local community college, thus this program and its graduates remain in high demand. However, the dental hygiene programs have limited capacity due to the need for a dental chair and equipment for each student. Given its current resources the program can only accept 28 new students per year (AS and BS combined).
- Currently there are no dedicated support staff for the Department of Allied Health, and only 5 faculty remaining (including the department chair). Using the RAMP model template, tuition income from the Dental Hygiene programs should be sufficient to support the needed faculty and staff salaries. The Dental Hygiene clinic also generates a small amount of income, which helps cover the cost of supplies used in the clinic.
- In 2018, the Institute for Rural Health was also moved into the Department of Allied Health. The Institute for Rural Health is a research and service center, which had previously been funded by the College of Health and Human Services. The Institute for Rural Health was shifted to the



Department of Allied Health with its staff and mission intact, but without a clear line of funding to support the IRH staff salaries and operating expenses, which placed considerable strain upon both the IRH staff and the department of Allied Health.

- The Institute for Rural Health Director and Registered Nurse both resigned late 2018. There are currently 3 full-time IRH staff members remaining – a dentist – now acting IRH director, dental hygienist, and an office coordinator. Since 2017 these staff members have been shared between the Dental Hygiene programs and the Institute for Rural Health. Utilization of the IRH staff has facilitated the operation of the Dental Clinic, a required component of the Dental Hygiene program.
- The IRH generates about \$60,000 a year in re-occurring grant income, which primarily covers supplies and expenses related to delivery of preventive health services (e.g. flu shots, various health screenings, dental cleanings, dental sealants, and fluoride treatments). However, the Institute has been unable to generate enough in grant funding or revenue to cover the salaries for the staff associated with the IRH. Obtaining grant or donor funds for staff salaries has been very difficult, as many grants specify that salaries cannot be paid using grant funds.
- The School of Nursing, as the largest CHHS unit, has several programs which should generate positive income under the RAMP model, and also has generated significant DELO funding in the past. At present these factors should allow the School of Nursing to assist the Department of Allied Health during the transition to the RAMP model. The School of Nursing should also be able to provide support for the Institute for Rural Health while additional resources are sought to fund the IRH, or an alternate method of staffing is devised.
- The School of Nursing, the Department of Allied Health and the Institute for Rural Health have workforce development components that serve South-Central Kentucky. Students from both dental hygiene and nursing have participated in community based experiences scheduled through the Institute for Rural Health. This year the School of Nursing has partnered with the IRH and with dental hygiene to develop a grant proposal to fund combined nursing and dental hygiene services in the community setting.
- These units have significant potential to partner with regional industry and develop partnerships that support academics through work on joint projects to solve real world problems. In addition, nursing and dental hygiene have programs that are accredited, and can share resources related to the accreditation processes.
- This proposal aligns closely related programs that share the same fundamental mission of preparing students for the workforce in health-related fields. This is in keeping with the Kentucky Workforce Readiness initiatives.
- Departmental lines will be removed to allow the formation of programmatic and research synergies in an effort to develop new programs to serve the region (ie. Nursing and Dental Hygiene, Community Health and the Institute for Rural Health.) This will also allow us to provide the administrative infrastructure necessary to support growth and development.
- Sharing of resources, staff, administration, and community clinics will improve communication, reduce redundancy, improve efficiency, and better serve student needs.
- Dr. Mary Bennett, Director of the School of Nursing will be the Director of the School of Nursing and Allied Health. Dr. Terry Dean, current Head of the Department of Allied Health, will return to full-time faculty status.

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**TRANSFER OF PROPERTY LOCATED AT 2341 HADLEY-COHRON ROAD TO THE COLLEGE HEIGHTS FOUNDATION**

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**REQUEST:**

Authorization to transfer 43.58 acres of land from WKU to the WKU Real Estate Corporation to sell the property and create a scholarship fund for Biology Department graduate students.

**FACTS:**

The Potter Nicely Outdoor Education Center located at 2341 Hadley-Cohron Road is a 48.22-acre farm donated by Ms. Sallie Carwell. The original 43.58 acres of land was donated in 2002 to Western Kentucky University. Subsequently, an additional tract of 4.64 acres, along with a home and related outbuildings, was donated in 2012 to the WKU Real Estate Corporation. The property has been used as a teaching and research center by the WKU Biology Department, and graduate students in Biology have occupied the home.

Currently, the home does not have any graduate students living on the property and the physical structures located on the WKU Real Estate Corporation tract have considerable deferred maintenance. While Ms. Carwell has provided some assistance for deferred maintenance, it does not resolve the fact that there is no long-term endowment to care for the property. Additionally, we recognize that the Biology Department now has research opportunities at the Green River Preserve.

After considering various options, Ms. Carwell agreed that the best course of action is to sell the property with the proceeds being used to establish a scholarship fund for graduate students in the Biology Department. The WKU Real Estate Corporation will assist with the sale of both tracts. The original 43.58 acre was appraised for \$65,000 when it was donated in 2002.

The proceeds will create a scholarship fund that will be held and administered by the College Heights Foundation. The College Heights Foundation will work with Ms. Carwell on guidelines for establishing this important scholarship to honor the Potter and Nicely legacies.

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**TRANSFER OF PROPERTY LOCATED AT 521 EMMETT AVENUE**

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**REQUEST:**

Authorization to receive .53 acres of land located at 521 Emmett Avenue from WKU Real Estate Corporation to WKU.

**FACTS:**

During 2015, properties located along the 500 block of Emmett Avenue were identified as potential acquisition targets by WKU for their ability to improve connections between Main and South Campus locations. The following year, the University was presented with an opportunity to secure all of the three previously identified properties. WKU selected the best candidate and approached the WKU Real Estate Corporation about approving the purchase of 521 Emmett Avenue to hold in reserve on behalf of WKU.

The property appraised for \$160,000 and the WKU Real Estate Corporation subsequently initiated the purchase on 08/24/2016 for \$155,500. The property was .53 acres and included a 1,525 well-maintained residence. WKU Real Estate Corporation then entered into a rental agreement lease of the property to a tenant to cash flow its purchase price.

The Parking and Transportation Department then discovered that the construction of a road would significantly increase transit efficacies by reducing the number of drivers and fuel use while improve services by reducing ride times. These advantages were in addition to the known safety advantages to drivers and riders by avoiding the Story and Emmett Avenue traffic signals on Nashville Road. Once it was determined that the return on investment for the construction of a new road was estimated to be in the range of 3-5 years, WKU fast-tracked the project to take advantage of operational savings.

The Parking and Transportation Department applied its foundation resources towards WKU Real Estate Corporation debt and on October 2017 entered into a department agreement to lease the property for eight years at \$11,282 annually. The lease agreement allowed for the demolition of the residence, allowed for the construction of a road, and stated that the property will to revert to the University once the final payment was received.

Parking and Transportation is in the process of retiring this obligation early.
