Callidium variabile. In Neath.
Carabus arcensis. On Hirwain Common.
Donacia dentipes. At Aberdylais, on *Iris pseudacorius*.

Galeruca rustica. On the Mountain—Mark Howell.
Helobia Marshallana. On the Beacons.
Hylobius Abietis. Near Neath.
Malthinus minimus. Aberdylais Wood.
Peryphus concinnus. Sides of the River Dylais.

 ——— *nitidulus*. Banks of the River Dylais.
 ——— *saxatilis*. Sides of the River Dylais.
