

College Heights Blvd Closing May 17th

College Heights Boulevard, between College Street and Alumni Drive, will be closed beginning May 17, 2011, for repairs. The Hub Lot, located next to the Rock House, will be closed while these repairs are made.

Detours will be established to maintain access to Florence Schneider Hall and Alumni Drive via the lower portion of College Heights Boulevard. Vehicles will approach from University Boulevard at Parking Structure 1 and turn left onto College Heights Boulevard. The portion of College Heights Boulevard between Parking Structure 1 and Florence Schneider Hall will be two-way for the duration of the project. When the project is complete, all of College Heights Boulevard will have two-way traffic.

Hilltop Drive will remain open for the duration of the project. Avenue of Champions will not be affected by this project. This is one of many projects which will affect traffic circulation on the top of the Hill this summer. The complete road closure of College Heights Boulevard is necessary to finish this project as effectively and quickly as possible. The reopening of College Heights Boulevard will facilitate traffic circulation during the remaining steam line and water line repair projects which will affect Alumni Drive, Hilltop Drive and Faculty House Drive later in the summer. This project is expected to be completed by June 15, 2011.

Alumni Drive/Hilltop Drive

Alumni Drive/Hilltop Drive to Faculty House Drive has been closed through Aug. 12. Potter Lot will remain open and traffic will exit through Faculty House Drive. Painting of the exterior of Potter Hall began on Tuesday and will continue through June 1, depending on weather. A steam line repair project will begin May 31 and continue through Aug. 12. Alternate parking will be available in the Gated Hilltop Lot for Premium Faculty/Staff permit holders.

Another steam line repair project will close the circular drive around Minton Hall will from May 31 through July 29. Partial access to disability parking spaces will be maintained. Additional meter parking is available in the Visitor Parking Area in front of Diddle Arena.
