\$500.00 Scholarship Criteria

1. Those eligible for consideration include the following:
 - **2009-2010 Graduating Senior from Bowling Green High School, Greenwood High School, Warren Central High School, or Warren East High School.**
 - **2009-2010 Western Kentucky University (WKU) sophomore, junior, or senior from the main and south campus.**
 - **Previous NAACP Bowling Green/ Warren County Branch recipients may also apply.**
2. An applicant must currently reside in Bowling Green/Warren County (KY), and be enrolled in a college or university for the fall 2010 semester. Applicants are not eligible to apply if they have been awarded financial assistance to cover **all** expenses billed by the institution.
3. Each student must enclose a recent copy of an unofficial or official transcript.
4. Three recommendation letters must be submitted by a non-relative of the applicant, two academic and one character. An **academic** letter must be written by a **teacher, professor, principal, or school counselor**. A **character** letter should be written by an individual such as, but not limited to, a mentor, church pastor, work supervisor, or organization or club leader.
5. The student must have a cumulative **2.5 Grade Point Average (GPA)** when applying, and **maintain it** for the term of the scholarship.
6. The recipient of the award will be expected to attend the Freedom Fund Gala held during the fall 2010 semester.

Please complete the scholarship award application on the reverse side, and mail it to the address below.

Packets must be postmarked on or by March 1, 2010. Interviews will be conducted for finalists during the second week of April 2010, and recipients will be notified by May 1, 2010. **INCOMPLETE APPLICATIONS WILL NOT BE CONSIDERED.**
