Western Kentucky University offers several types of scholarships for both traditional and non-traditional beginning freshmen who will begin attendance in the fall semester. These scholarships include Academic, Leadership, Departmental, Diversity, and Tuition Incentive Program (TIP) Scholarships.

Academic scholarships are awarded competitively on the basis of ACT/SAT scores, cumulative grade point average on a 4.0 unweighted scale, rank in class, curriculum, activities, and honors. Leadership scholarships are awarded based on demonstrated leadership activities in high school and leadership potential.

Some scholarships also are available through certain academic departments. Students are encouraged to contact these departments for additional information. Western also offers Tuition Incentive Program (TIP) Scholarships to qualified students who are residents of specific counties in Tennessee, Illinois, Indiana, Ohio and Missouri. For more information, refer to our website.

Although the University Scholarship Committee cannot offer scholarships to all applicants, we assure that each application will receive careful consideration and fair treatment in what is a very competitive situation. To receive full consideration by the scholarship committee, applications must be postmarked by JANUARY 15. Applications postmarked after January 15 will not be given full consideration. **All scholarship applicants will be notified by mid May.**

Applicants for the Alumni Leadership Scholarship are required to submit both the Scholarship Application **and** a two page, double-spaced essay on the applicant's experiences and goals as a leader. A total of five awards are offered.

The subsequent pages list all Western Kentucky University Scholarships for incoming freshmen and the Scholarship Application. **While it is not necessary to apply for a specific award**, some scholarships do have additional requirements. These scholarships are indicated by an asterisk (\*).

**Your scholarship application cannot be considered unless all information is complete.** You must notify the Office of Student Financial Assistance of any outside scholarships you receive.

Please contact your high school guidance office about additional off-campus scholarship opportunities.

## INSTRUCTIONS

Read the Scholarship listings carefully and complete the enclosed/attached application. If, after reading the instructions and the entire application, you have further questions, please contact the Office of Student Financial Assistance at (270) 745-2755 or e-mail [scholarships@wku.edu](mailto:scholarships@wku.edu). 1. Submit an application for undergraduate admission prior to the submission of the Scholarship Application. Scholarship Applications cannot be considered unless an application for admission is on file.
2. Print clearly or type responses to Parts I, III, and IV.
3. Take the completed application to your high school guidance counselor to complete Part II. The applicant's guidance counselor must complete the appropriate section of the Scholarship Application. A transcript and grading scale must be included with the scholarship application.
4. Mail the completed application to the Office of Student Financial Assistance at the following address:

5. **The Scholarship Application must be postmarked no later than January 15. Late scores and adjusted class rank cannot be accepted.**

**Generally, a 3.7 cumulative unweighted grade point average and a 27 composite ACT score (or 1170 SAT) are desirable to be competitive for most academic scholarships.**

Need may not be a factor in scholarship decisions. However, receipt of a scholarship may require an adjustment in a financial aid package. Western Kentucky University reserves the right to adjust individual scholarship awards after award letters have been sent to effectively utilize federal and university dollars or to prevent conflicting scholarship awards.
