Health Services provides learning and leadership opportunities for the development of its students in many ways.

- -Internships are provided to health care, business, student affairs and pre clinical students
- -Undergraduate students are hired as work study students who then gain valuable and relevant work experience in health care.

- -Our Peer Health Educators staff our Wellness Resource room, which serves as an interactive learning community is utilized by fellow students in preparation for class assignments and by various faculty looking for resources on health topics.
