Every student will finish with a unique plan of his/her own depending on the minor area of study, electives selected, etc. These four year plans are examples to help map your degree program in consultation with your broadcast faculty advisor.

Note: To meet ACEJMC accreditation standards, students must complete 80 hours outside of the major including 65 hours of liberal arts and natural sciences. If the minor selected is not in a liberal arts or science subject (LAS), then the student can expect to take more hours than the University requirement of 128 hours for graduation.
