Directions & Maps

From the North: Take I-75 south to Rt. 25E (Exit 29) and proceed East 17 mi to Barbourville.

From the South: Take I-75 north to Exit US-25. Continue on US-25 0.7 mi. Bear Right to take the ramp and merge onto KY-3041 (Corbin Bypass) 5.6 mi. Exit Right onto US-25E 13.4 mi. to Barbourville.

From the East: Take the Daniel Boone Pkwy from Hazard 38.44 mi. Exit KY-80 turn Right onto KY-80 East 0.13 mi. Turn Right onto US-421/KY-11/KY-80. Continue to follow KY-11 22.57 mi. Turn Left onto US-25E South and follow North directions (above) from this point.

From the West: Take Cumberland Pkwy; proceed to I-75 and go South. Follow North directions (above) from this point.

Once in Barbourville: Turn Right on KY-11 0.3 mi. Bear Right on KY 2421 0.1 mi. Continue on College Street 0.1 mi. to Union College.
