BUSINESS, B.S. transfer plan

Western Kentucky University

Purpose: To promote transfer of credits from the A.A. or A.S. degree from KCTCS into a B.S. in Business at WKU.

Accreditation Statues: Both institutions will observe SACS and the AACSB International – The Association to Advance Collegiate Schools of Business.

Admissions of Practices: Applicants for the Western Kentucky University's Bachelor of Science in Business require the following criteria:

- 1. Admission to WKU.
- 2. A minimum overall 2.5 GPA.
- 3. A 2.5 GPA in the eight admission courses (WKU courses: COMM 161/145; MATH 116 (or higher); CIS 141/CS 145; ACCT 200, ACCT 201; ECON 202, ECON 203, ECON 206). KCTCS courses: COM 181 (OC), MAT 150 (QR), CIS 1000/100B/105/130 or equivalent to WKU CIS 141/145, ACC 201 and 202/208, ECO 201 (SB), ECO 202 (SB) and equivalent to WKU ECON 206.

Program Delivery Style: Management, Business Administrative option offered at WKU extended campus locations. Classes for this major are offered either IVS, in-class at extended campus locations, or as a web-instructed course.

Application of Credits:

- 1. This agreement allows KCTCS graduates to transfer an AA or AS from KCTCS in its entirety toward completion of a B.S. in one of several business programs at WKU.
- 2. The following BS programs from WKU are available, with each requiring 70-77 credit hours.

Business Economics
Business Informatics
Finance – Financial Planning Option
Finance – Financial Management Option
Management – Business Administration
Management – Human Resource Mgt Option
Marketing – Strategic Marketing Option
Marketing – Sales Option

NOTE: Only the Management Business Administration option is offered for completion at WKU extended campus locations.

- 3. Students must complete WKU's General Education requirements and comply with all Academic Requirements and Regulations (as published in the undergraduate catalog).
