



## Transfer Plan to WKU:

# TECHNOLOGY MANAGEMENT, B.S.

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**Purpose:** To promote transfer of credits from the Associate in Applied Science (A.A.S.) or Associate of Science (AS) or Associate of Arts (A.A.) degree from any KCTCS institution or two years degree granting institutions into the B.S. in Technology Management at WKU.

### Admissions Process:

Applicants for the Western Kentucky University's Bachelor of Science Technology Management require the following criteria:

1. No particular associate degree is specified.
2. If the student begins at WKU before completing the A.A.S., A.A., or A.S. but then goes on to complete the AAS, AA or A.S. at KCTCS or two year degree granting institutions, this plan for a BS in Technology Management can be utilized.
3. Admission to WKU.
4. All transfer students must request that an official transcript from each college attended be sent to the WKU Admissions Office, 1906 College Heights Blvd. #11020, Bowling Green, KY 42101-1020, or preferable electronically, or call (270)745-2551 if you have questions. ### Application of Credits:

1. This agreement permits KCTCS graduates to transfer an AAS or AA or AS from KCTCS.
2. Transfer students in the Technology Management program must complete WKU's General Education requirements and comply with all published Academic Requirements and Regulations (see WKU Catalog for details). Additional general education coursework needed to fulfill a WKU BS degree program may be taken through WKU or KCTCS.
3. While working on the AAS at KCTCS, students are encouraged to complete the following courses as a foundation for the BS in Technology Management: MAT 150 (QR) or equivalent to Math 116 at WKU; and QMS 240 (substitutes for AMS 271).
4. The table below outlines the requirements for a BS in Technology Management, once the AAS, AA, or AS is completed. Two options are outlined: 1) transfer to WKU for remaining requirements, or 2) to continue at KCTCS until General Education courses are completed. There is a third option for the student that completes the AA or AS in addition to the AAS. In this third option, no additional General Education courses are necessary and the student only needs to complete 42 hours at WKU courses (the Technology Management courses listed below). A total of 120 credit hours are required for a WKU B.S. degree.
