Community College Faculty Preparation Program

Characteristics of the CCFP program include:

- *Discipline-independent program consisting of three graduate courses
- *Pre-/co-requisite: master's degree with 18 hours in a teaching discipline
- *Optional to students and to academic departments/programs within the University

Community College Faculty Preparation Courses

The CCFP program includes three required courses.

Adult Education (ADED) 611 - Adult Development and Learning. 3 hours

Prerequisite: Admission to CCFP program or permission of instructor

Educational Foundations (EDFN) 612 - Seminar in Community College Teaching. 3 hours

Prerequisite: ADED 611 or permission of instructor

Adult Education (ADED) 520 – Methods for Teaching Adults 3 hours

Adult Education (ADED) 590—Practicum in Adult Education

or

Academic Discipline 589 -- Internship in Community College Teaching. 3 hours

Prerequisite: EDFN 612 or permission of instructor

Any departmental internship course (3 hours) may be used to fulfill this certificate requirement.

Community College Faculty Preparation Certificate

Completion of the CCFP program and an appropriate master's degree will culminate in the awarding of a Certificate by the University. The Certificate provides evidence that the student has completed the program.
