Duties shall include providing intensive in-home services to families and children utilizing a strengths-based approach. Responsibilities include teaching a wide range of skills using a cognitive-behavioral model in such areas as crisis management, parent education, home management, and conflict resolution. Additional responsibilities include providing crisis counseling, concrete supports and linkages, reporting and thorough documentation. This position requires excellent written and verbal communication skills and computer skills including word processing, spreadsheets, and internet, as well as an ability to effectively maintain and manage a flexible work schedule that includes evening, weekend, and on-call work.

**Qualifications:**

**Minimum qualifications for this position include a Bachelor's Degree in social work or closely related human services field; a minimum of two years' experience working with families and/or children; and all appropriate licenses, registrations, and/or certifications. A valid Kentucky Driver's License and dependable transportation are a job requirement.**
