

AOL Meeting Oct. 27, 2014

Present: Zimmer, Spiller, Snively, Cosby, Crews, & Blankenship

The minutes from the last meeting were approved with changes. The only change was for the recommendation that any faculty member with presentation skills could do a workshop in Mgt. 210 or Mgt. 498.

Shane Spiller will provide data from Mgt. 210 for the Ethical and Global Awareness undergraduate goals.

The committee will begin evaluate the Strategic and Critical Thinking goal for the PMBAs. Results are due back to the chair on Nov. 7.

There was conversation to use discussion board forums in the MBA classes to evaluate Ethical Awareness. The committee feels that there is a lack of ethical awareness being infused into the MBA curriculum.

Ethical Awareness results from the face-to-face and online MBA delivery methods were both at the unacceptable level. It is the recommendation of the AOL committee to incorporate an Ethics course for all three delivery methods for the MBA program.

New Business

Thad Crews joined the committee as the representative from the Information Systems department.

Shane spiller met with Ron Bunch concerning an external survey that will be used by the chamber of commerce to gather AOL indirect measures from our graduates.

There was a discussion to see if BA175 instructors are covering ethical issues with students related to plagiarism, cheating, and an ethical code of conduct. There was concern that not all students take BA 175.
