

Minutes of the Curriculum Committee
Gordon Ford College of Business
April 21, 2015

The Curriculum Committee of the Gordon Ford College of Business met on Tuesday, April 21, 2015 at 2:30 p.m. in the Dean's Conference Room, Room 443. Members present included: Dr. LeAnne Coder, Dr. Claudia Strow, Dr. Mark Ross, Dr. Evelyn Thrasher, Dr. Pat Jordan and Dr. Michelle Trawick, Dr. Rick Shannon and Dr. Indu Chhachhi.

A motion was made by Dr. Strow and seconded by Dr. Thrasher to approve the minutes from the March 31, 2015. Minutes were approved.

Dr. Trawick opened the discussion on differential admission standards. After more discussion about the various options a motion was made by Dr. Strow to vote to accept differential admission standards for departments.. The motion carried by a vote of 4/2. Below is the breakdown of GFCB Departmental Admission Standards.

GFCB Departmental Admission Criteria

The set of BASE admissions courses for the GFCB are:

MATH 116 or higher
COMM 145
CIS 141
ACCT 200
ACCT 201
ECON 202
ECON 203
ECON 206

Each department may choose up to three courses as SUPPLEMENTAL admissions courses.

Each department must identify a minimum of six courses (18 hours) from which an admissions GPA will be calculated for each student seeking admission into that department's major. At least five BASE courses must be included in the admissions GPA calculation.

It was also mentioned that if faculty choose to change admissions criteria, please identify any SUPPLEMENTAL courses and the courses to be used in the admissions GPA calculation as soon as you can. Once we receive those, we will provide them to the advising office. We will all need to update our areas of the undergraduate catalog this summer to reflect the changes.
