Beginning Freshman – A student who has not attended a college or university after high school graduation.

Records Needed: An *official* high school transcript (no faxed transcripts accepted) *and* ACT or SAT scores.

Transfer – A student who has attended one or more colleges or universities since high school graduation but has not attended WKU.

Records Needed: An official transcript from each college attended. No faxed transcripts are accepted. Transcripts without the official seal or those marked unofficial cannot be used. If you have fewer than 24 semester hours of college credit earned, you must also submit an official high school transcript and ACT or SAT scores.

Non-Degree Seeking – A student who is not seeking a degree from WKU.

Records Needed: No records are needed.

Readmission – A student who has attended WKU since high school graduation.

Records Needed: An official transcript from each college attended, other than WKU.

Visitor – A student seeking a degree from another college wishing to attend WKU for one term only.

Records Needed: Transient permission form (This form will be sent to you by the Office of Admissions upon receipt of the application and processing fee) Letter of good standing may be substituted.

Prior to High School Graduation – A student who is still attending high school but who wishes to take a University course.

Records Needed: An *official* high school transcript, ACT scores, if taken, and a letter from high school guidance counselor approving student to take course.
