**Qualifications:**

Candidates must have an earned doctorate, special education emphasis (ABD considered with a confirmed defense date), and public school teaching/clinical experience in special education. Specific interest and expertise in teaching courses related to autism spectrum disorders. Ability to incorporate technology into the classroom/clinical setting, and experience with web based instruction and other distance learning is expected. Candidates should be able to successfully participate in grant writing, special projects, and serve on committees as requested.
