KCTICS Transfer Students

WKU has a unique partnership with KCTICS that allows you to apply your AAS degree towards the completion of the CIT major. Under this arrangement, WKU will accept your degree as a block transfer when you are admitted – and you start the CIT program as a Junior.

Students must complete the AAS degree **BEFORE** starting in the CIT program to take advantage of this partnership. WKU will not consider individual courses for transfer.

Students who transfer from KCTICS will need to complete WKU's General Education requirements. These may be completed at WKU, or your local community college.

Students may complete the 2+2 CIT option in as little as two years!!

All CIT courses are available online and may be completed from anywhere in the world. The "on-demand" format of these classes is compatible with busy work and family schedules.

____ Apply for admission to WKU; students may apply on line (www.wku.edu). Official transcripts must be sent from each college previously attended.

____ Students must apply for graduation upon the completion of 90 semester hours.

____ Students **MUST** have a minimum of 54 hours with WKU and an acceptable GPA to be eligible to graduate with honors. **Please consult a WKU academic advisor for details**

____ Students must have 42 upper-division hours (300-499).

____ Developmental courses (numbered below 100) cannot be used to satisfy graduation requirements.
