## Elementary Education Degree Requirements

Student must complete an AA degree with KCTCS to be fully general education certified. Apply for admission to WKU; achieve a minimum GPA of 2.5 overall, 2.5 in major and 2.5 in professional coursework.

Students MUST have a 2.5 average in ENG 101 & ENG 102 and a grade of "C" or better in COM 181. These courses must be completed a year before start of student teaching.

Attend Teacher Admissions Orientation. To be eligible to attend you must have a minimum GPA of 2.25 and have had or currently enrolled in ED 201 with ECIC or EDU 250 with WKU.

Students must apply for graduation upon the completion of 90 semester hours.

Students must earn a minimum of 54 semester hours with WKU (including 42 upper level hours) and an acceptable GPA to graduate with honors \*\*Please consult a WKU Academic advisor for details.

Students must have a 2.5 GPA, completed ED 201, EDP 202 and one of the scores listed below to be admitted to Pre-Block.

Students will need verification of one test score. ACT minimum composite score of 21 or SAT with minimum composite score of 990 or PRAXIS I with minimum scores of 173 in Reading, 173 in Math, and 172 in Writing. Student must provide verification of scores before course pass will be issued for Pre-Block classes.

Students Teacher Education file must be completed before a course pass can be issued for Block I classes. This includes having completed ENG 101, ENG 102, COM 181 and all three Teacher recommendations TA3 from ED 201, TA4 from one of (ART 310, MUS 311, MUS 314, PE 354, ENG 302, GEOG 451) TA6 from Pre-Block Clinical Instructor.

Students must have completed both MA 201 and MA 202 with ECIC or MATH 211 and MATH 212 with WKU before a course pass can be issued for Block II classes.

Includes 25% of the minimum number of semester hours required in the student's degree program earned in residence (at Western), with at least 16 hours completed in residence after the semester in which 90 cumulative hours have been earned.
