 - 2a) Applicants who have limited prior academic background in business are required to demonstrate proficiency in six major areas by: (a) successfully completing one or more foundation courses as specified by the MBA Director, OR (b) successfully completing one or more core area proficiency exams (fees required).
 - 3) A maximum of six (6) semester hours of graduate credit earned at another institution or through military credit may be accepted toward meeting course requirements for the graduate program.
 - 4) A final written comprehensive examination must be passed.
 - 5) Thesis is not required
 - 6) Program courses may not be taken without FULL admission to the MBA Program. Full Admission entails an acceptable GAP score, reported GMAT score taken within the last five years, current resume, one professional reference, and official transcript. GAP score: GMAT score of 500 and GPAX200 plus GMAT equal to 1050.
 - 7) All requirements for the master's degree must be completed within six years from the date the first course is taken. Failure to complete a degree in six years will result in the loss of all credits taken outside of the time limit.
 - 8) All distance learning degree programs must meet the approval of the WKU Graduate Studies Office before credit hours can be used as transfer credits.
 - 9) Before any MBA core (Tier II) classes can be taken, a series of prerequisite (Tier I) classes must be satisfied. See above list of Tier I requirements.
