## For Exploratory/Undeclared students

### **Declaring A Major**

Students that have attempted and earned 59+ hours will have a hold placed on their account. The hold requires these students to change their major.

To change your major, login to <u>TopNet</u>. Click on the tab at the top that says "Student Services." Under this tab, click on "Student Records."

Choose the option "Change major, minor, concentration, advisor."

From the drop-down menu for Major 1, select your new major, which may say "Seeking Admission." This means your major has a set of requirements you must fulfill in order to be officially accepted into the program. You may also select a minor, concentration, or second major at this time.

You should also request a change in advisor from the down-down menu.

February 18, 2013

Submit the information, and confirm the changes on the next page.

Print out the form. You need a signature from your new major's department head. Bring the form to the office listed on the change of major printout.

If you are still unsure of a major, be sure to look through all WKU undergraduate academic programs here.
