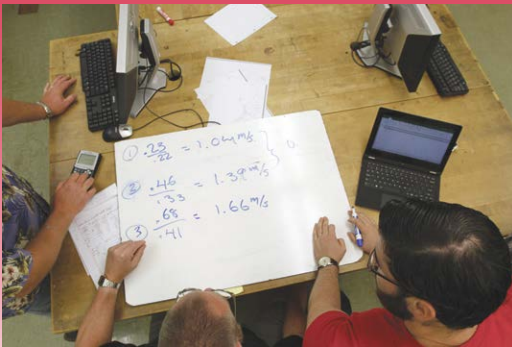

## HOW MUCH WILL IT COST?

The \$650 registration fee for each of the workshops covers the cost of instruction, College Board Advanced Placement packets, and other training materials. The registration fee does not include the cost of housing, meals, or airport transportation.

## WHERE CAN I STAY?

Accommodations will be available with single rooms in an air-conditioned residence hall. Each room shares a bathroom with one other participant. The cost of the residence hall is \$25 per night for a single room. Plan to bring towels, bed linens, and a pillow. No children can be accommodated in the residence hall. CEUs will be available for interested participants for a small fee.
