Dress Code for SCATS

The Center for Gifted Studies encourages campers to wear clothes that motivate them to be confident and successful.

The following items are **NOT** allowed in the dress code:

- ⊗ Oversized or low-riding pants
- ⊗ Muscle shirts
- ⊗ Pajamas (not for class, meals, or activities)
- ⊗ Ripped, torn, or see-through clothing
- ⊗ Tops that expose the midriff, any part of the bust (cleavage) or excessive parts of the back, or are excessively tight or distracting
- ⊗ Attire that detracts from learning

The following points are important to remember about clothing for camp:

- ✓ Long tops (tunics), skirts, or shorts must cover leggings as leggings or tights do not replace pants.
- ✓ Form-fitting exercise clothing is only appropriate when working out.
- ✓ Shorts, dresses, and skirts must provide full coverage at all times, including when bending or moving.
- ✓ All lettering, slogans, and artwork on clothing must be in good taste.
- ✓ Shirts and pants must meet while sitting, standing, bending, and reaching in the air.
- ✓ Athletic shoes or comfortable walking shoes are important. (We are known as the Hilltoppers!)

If clothing doesn't meet the dress code, staff will have the right to send campers back to change their clothes.
