APPLICATION PROCEDURE PROGRAM OF HEALTH INFORMATION MANAGEMENT BACCALUREATE DEGREE

Students must submit an application to the Program of Health Information Management by **May 1**st for admission to the fall semester and by **December 1**st for admission for the spring semester; late acceptance may be considered. The application may be obtained at http://www.wku.edu/healthinformation management.

Please note the following:

- Official acceptance to Western Kentucky University is a requirement for applying to the baccalaureate degree Health Information Management (BS HIM) program; program applications from non-WKU students will not be considered.
- Admission to the College of Health & Human Services or the University does not guarantee admission to the program.
- Acceptance into the baccalaureate (BS) program is based on a selective admission process and is based on space available. Applicants are considered on a competitive basis. There are no restrictions regarding age, sex, race, religion, disability, sexual orientation or marital status.
- HIM 100 (or equivalent) must be successfully completed with a grade of "C" or higher before acceptance into the HIM program and overall GPA must be at least a 2.0.
