

HEALTH EMPHASIS

The Health Area of Emphasis draws from a number of disciplines to allow students to explore health care issues, public health topics, and factors related to physical and emotional well-being. Students will achieve a generalist's understanding of the vast array of concerns affecting the health professions. Students could use this degree to work in health departments or educational settings, or other organizations that don't require specialized skills, or as preparation for graduate studies.
