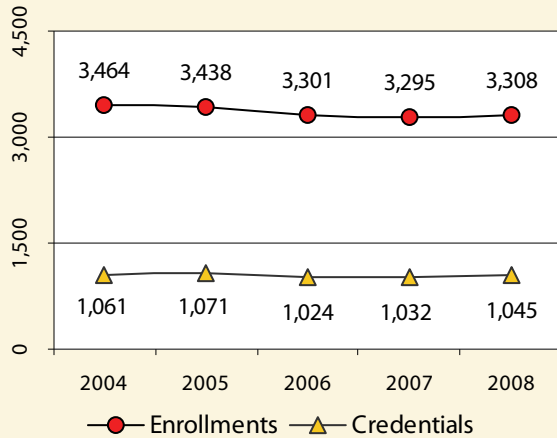

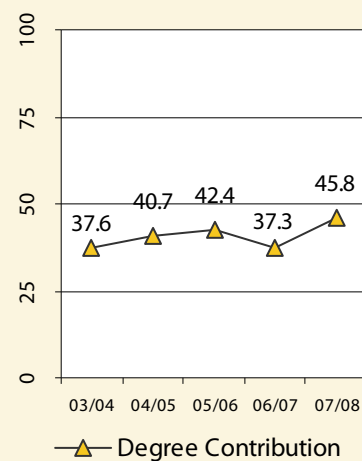

2003/04 - 2007/08



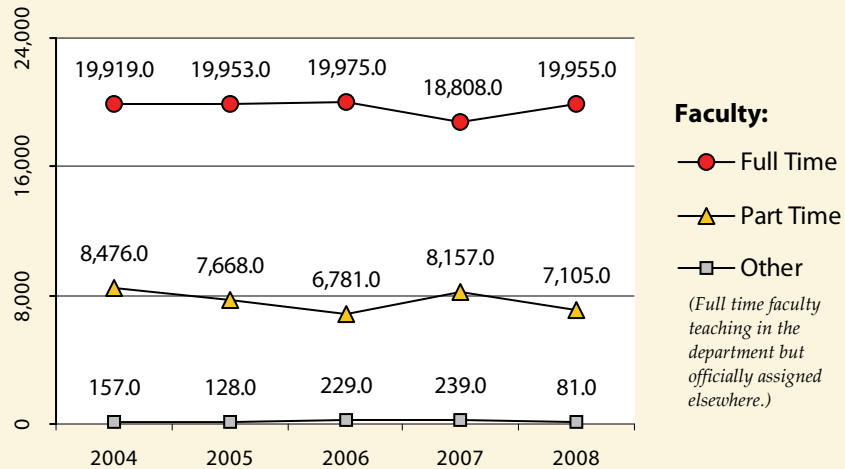
Departments receive degree production credit proportional to the number of non-general education courses a student took that contributed toward a University College Degree.
