

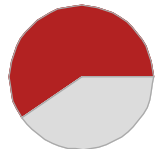

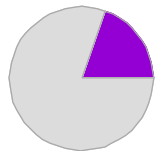

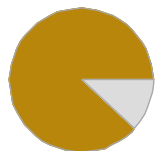
Potter College of Arts & Letters Student Profile Fall 2011 - 2015



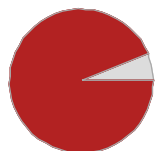
In Arts & Letters, **females** make up **59%** of the student population.

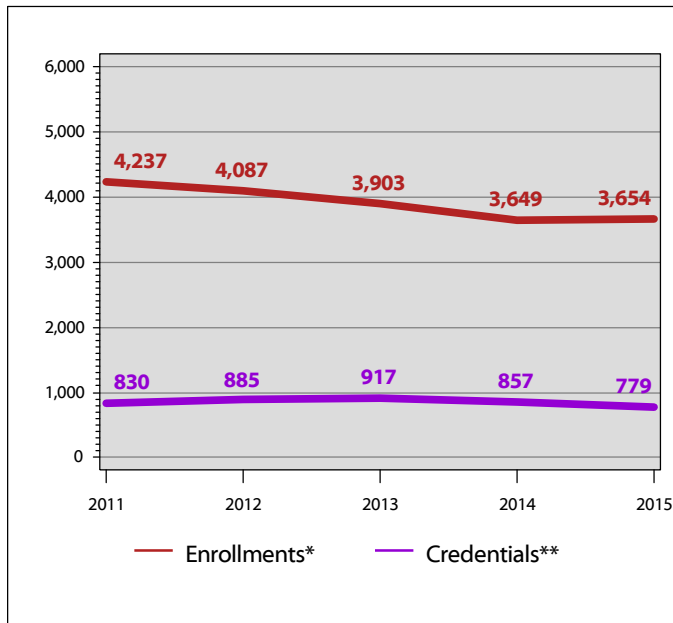
