Charge to the committee

- Prepare for the implementation of Windows 7 on WKU-owned computers.
- Identify and resolve technical problems.
- Develop a list of software and services to be tested, including web apps with IE 8.
- Develop Windows 7 computer images for our various computers and user groups.
- Recommend campus standards and keep IT Directors informed about key issues.
- Test all services provided by the IT Division and document readiness for Windows 7.
- Roll out Windows 7 to labs and faculty/staff desktops on a test basis in Spring 2011.
- Maintain FAQ page and guide campus communications.
- Develop support and training program for WKU users.
- Implement Windows 7 in all open labs, new faculty pool computers, reclaimed faculty pool computers, and most departmental labs/classrooms in Summer 2011.
