

STUDENT GOVERNMENT ASSOCIATION

The Student Government Association is composed of three branches: the executive, the legislative and the judicial. The executive branch consists of the President, Executive Vice President, Vice President of Finance, Vice President of Administration, and Vice President of Public Relations. Their main function is to coordinate the overall efforts of student government.

The President serves as student regent, chair of the executive committee, and representative of the student body. The Vice President for Public Relations is a representative to the Campus Activities Board and is responsible for promoting student government. The Executive Vice President presides over congress and deals with the routine business of SGA. The Vice President of Administration is responsible for maintaining accurate records of all Student Government Association activities. The Vice President of Finance is responsible for the financial affairs of student government. The legislative branch includes all elected members of Congress. Congressmen serve as a source for the various committees of the Student Government Association and participate in policy making through the Congress. The judicial branch includes the Judicial Council of the Student Government Association. This Council interprets and clarifies SGA=s constitution and by laws.

The Student Government Association is involved in several areas of campus activity including administering a faculty course evaluation, sponsoring the provide-a-ride program, participating in university affairs through representation on committees and working in academic affairs through the Academic Council and the College Curriculum Committee.
