

## *Departmental Organizations*

### AGRICULTURE BUSINESS CLUB

Serves to promote higher scholastic achievement among agriculture business and related majors, as well as foster a closer relationship among students in those majors.

### AGRICULTURE EDUCATION CLUB

Helps to develop skill and experience in organizing and conducting a club or organization and to promote cooperation, goodwill, recreation and educational opportunities for its members.

### AIR & WASTE MANAGEMENT ASSOCIATION

This organization serves to promote air pollution control and waste management through the use of science. This group also hopes to identify potential pollution and waste problems and notify the public, legislators and administrators regionally and globally.

### AMERICAN SOCIETY of CIVIL ENGINEERS
