

DENTAL HYGIENE CLINIC

The Program of Dental Hygiene is an academic program administered through the Department of Allied Health, with the primary purpose of educating students to become professional dental hygienists. Through this program, the dental hygiene students provide dental health education and preventive services to Western students, faculty, staff, and non-affiliates. The service includes examination of the mouth, dental prophylaxis (cleaning and polishing of teeth), dental X-rays, and applications of fluoride and dental sealants. The dental hygiene clinic, located in room 223 of the Academic Complex, is open Monday and Wednesday during the fall semester, and Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday during the spring semester.
