

GARRETT CONFERENCE CENTER

The Garrett Conference Center was constructed in 1953 as the campus student center. When the Downing University Center opened, the Board of Regents designated the Garrett Center to be used primarily for meetings and special University events. The Center houses a cafeteria, a Subway, a ballroom with a capacity of 1,100 persons, several meeting rooms, and the offices for the Herald, the Correspondence Study office, and Student Disability Services.
