

COLLEGE HEIGHTS FOUNDATION

The primary purpose of the College Heights Foundation is to aid qualified students with the emphasis on scholarship awards and emergency loans. The Foundation serves Western as an agency for the receiving, collecting, generating and protecting of funds to be used to aid as many needy and worthy students as possible. Scholarship awards are made through the University Scholarship Committee, and loans are made by committee through the University's Office of Student Financial Assistance and the Office of the Controller. The College Heights Foundation is also a depository for financial gifts designated to be held in perpetuity, and earnings from trust funds provide substantial help for the students.

The Foundation is operated under a Board of Directors, serving without remuneration. Mr. H. Alexander Downing is President. Dr. Dero Downing, President Emeritus of Western, is Chairman of the Board of Directors of the College Heights Foundation. Ms. Mary Sample is the Executive Secretary.

The Foundation Building is located just north of the Wetherby Administration Building, and the Foundation offices are on the main floor.
