

Gifted Student Service Plans

The Gifted Student Service Plan component of the Individual Learning Plan (ILP) brings the data from the student information system (SIS) into the ILP. Educators can view the service plan areas for each student, enter additional details about the services students are receiving, document meetings and document communications with parents.

Kentucky offers gifted education services for identified students across all grade levels. Primary students are screened and selected as high potential learners and students in grades 4-12 are formally identified for services in one or more of the following areas:

- ❖ General intellectual aptitude
- ❖ Specific academic aptitude
- ❖ Creative or divergent thinking
- ❖ Psychosocial or leadership skills
- ❖ Visual or performing arts

Imported Gifted Student Service Plan Data

The basic data for the Gifted Student Service Plans is imported annually from the student information system. The imported data includes:

- ❖ The service plan categories
- ❖ Year identified and date the plan started
- ❖ Underachieving status
- ❖ Whether or not services have been declined
- ❖ Evidence for gifted identification
- ❖ Basic services being received

The GSSP features within the ILP build on the data imported from the student information system. If a student is not included in the SIS data, educators will not have access to the GSSP module for that student within the ILP.

Accessing a Student's GSSP

If a student has been identified as gifted and talented, there is a new option in the View/Action dropdown in the Student List. If a student has not been included in the SIS data import, this option will not be available.

Components of the GSSP

The GSSP consists of three sections: Demographic Information, Service Plan Detail, and Communication and Documentation. A printer-friendly version of the GSSP is also available.

Demographics

The Demographics section displays fundamental data points for the student, such as date of birth, gender, and current school attended. This data is collected through the regular weekly data import. If there are inaccuracies in this information, please consult your student information system.

The demographic section also provides the option to record any special education accommodations that the student is receiving.

Service Plan Categories

Students can be identified as gifted in the areas listed above. Gifted students have a plan for each area in which he or she has been identified as gifted or talented.

The types of services that the student is receiving are included in the imported student information system data.

Educators can specify the individual service options that the student participates in as part of their plan.
