- ACT Composite Score of 18-25
- No Merit-Based Institutional Scholarship
- Counselor Recommendation

- Maintain acceptable GPA and Credit Hour Production (15 hrs. per semester)
- Welcome the intrusive and supportive nature of program
- Pursue assistance before it is too late
