Re: Regional Senior entry forms

And now, the time we've all been waiting for ... Regional Tournaments!!! I have included the Regional entry form in this mailing. You can also download a copy of the entry form from the web site. Please read the info below carefully before filling out your Regional entry form. More info concerning the State Tournaments will be sent out by E-mail in late January or early February.

Rules and regulations for Regional Tournaments are found on pages 46-47 of your handbook. Please make sure you pay attention to three areas: (1) Determining your entry, (2) Completing your entry form, and (3) Submitting your regional entry form.

Please keep the following in mind when completing your regional entry form:

- **Students who attend the regional tournament must be able to attend the state tournament if they qualify.** You should only enter students who can make this commitment. Any student who competes at Regionals, qualifies, and does not compete in the State Tournament will, except in cases of extreme emergency, be prohibited from competing in Regionals/State the following year. Any school that attends Regionals and qualifies students but does not attend the State Tournament will, except in cases of extreme emergency, be assessed drop fees for each qualifying entry and will be prohibited from competing in the following year's Regional and State Tournament. This has been a problem in the past. Schools have entered students at Regionals who did not come to the State Tournament. These students knocked others out of attending the State Tournament. **DO NOT** enter a student at Regionals unless you have a commitment from them to attend State.
- A student may compete in **three** events at Regionals this year. A school may enter a maximum of **three** students per event. This applies even if a student has prequalified in more than three events and/or a school has prequalified more than three students in a given event. Students and coaches will have to make some decisions. In order to stay prequalified, the student **must** be listed on the regional entry form and compete at Regionals. This would not apply if excused by the KHSSL Director in case of an emergency or major conflict.

Please do not hesitate to call for any clarifications. No additions may be made after the deadline, but substitutions are allowed up to the time of the tournament. Please keep in mind that, as noted in the handbook, substitutions after the deadline carry a \$10 fee. However, any major changes should be made ahead of time to make sure the tournament can run smoothly.

Please note that this is basically the same form that has been used for the last couple of years. Please follow these instructions when submitting your entry:

- Please **print or type** when completing the form. This will make it easier to process your entry.
- Please write both first and last names of students and judges. Remember to list titles/topics where required.
- Judges should know of their commitment before you list them on your form. If there is any school a judge needs to be coded against, please list that as well. You can find the number of judges required by looking at the fee sheet. Also please note that Regional Managers almost always need your judges at the tournament. Make sure you supply all required judges and try to fill your judging quota.

- After double-checking your entry, please double-check your math. Your entry fee amount needs to be accurate.

Submit your regional entry to your Regional Manager in the manner in which she or he has instructed you. It is required that a copy of your entry form reach your Regional Manager (not postmarked) at least **two weeks** before your regional tournament.

Send your regional entry **along with your entry fee** to the League office. The form and fee must be received at least **two weeks** before your regional tournament. Please make sure entries are received **with payment**, or your school will not be entered in the Regional Tournament. Please allow 5 business days for the entry to be received by this office. I will send an E-mail to each school after I receive your entry and payment.
