**I. PURPOSE**

The purpose of the KHSSL, Inc. Hall of Fame is to honor forensic colleagues who have had a long term commitment to Kentucky forensics through their promotion of excellence in the study, preparation, and/or performance of speech and dramatic arts in the state of Kentucky.

**II. QUALIFICATIONS**

- A. A least ten years of forensic service in the state of Kentucky.
- B. A high degree of integrity.
- C. Outstanding service above and beyond the call of duty.
- D. Willingness to help colleagues.
- E. Commitment to speech and dramatic arts education.
- F. Dedication to caring for the individual students and their futures.
- G. If the nominee is currently coaching in Kentucky, he or she must be an active participant at both the KHSSL regional and state tournaments.
- H. Retired coaches who meet criteria A-F may be nominated.

**III. SELECTION PROCESS**

At the July Board meeting, the KHSSL, Inc. Board Members may select not more than three members from a list of nominees supplied by member school to be inducted into the KHSSL, Inc. Forensic Hall of Fame at the State Tournament. Letter of support for candidates are welcome. All nomination forms/materials must be submitted to the League office no later than two weeks before the posted July Board meeting date.
