

Post-MSN Certificate: Nursing Education

This certificate is for students who have completed a master's degree in nursing and desire to pursue non-degree educational preparation to teach in schools of nursing in university and community college settings. The required courses focus on theories and strategies that guide instructional process, teaching and evaluation strategies and faculty role development. Students may transfer up to 6 credit hours of the requirements listed below if approved by a program advisor as equivalent.
