#### KANS and NSNA MEMBERSHIP

- NSNA membership is \$35 per year. This includes KANS membership and is encouraged, but not required for all BSN students. However, to run for office or be a class representative, students must be an active member of NSNA. Students are welcome to attend events without being a member.
- In order to list KANS membership on your resume, wear KANS cords at graduation, and receive all membership benefits noted on the NSNA website, you MUST have a paid membership.
