OCSE Travel Policy for Academic Year 2021-2022

OCSE priorities for travel funding for students and faculty are:

- Presentation of scholarly work at a national or international conference;
- Support for external funding efforts such as a response to reviewer comments from a grant proposal submitted within the past two years;
- Recruitment activities for graduate students such as working at least two hours at a student recruiting fair at a national or international conference; and/or
- Student on-site experiential learning opportunity(ies).

As always, OCSE strives to support the scholarship and professional development of faculty members as they move towards tenure and/or promotion. Applications should have some level of cost-share from their academic unit, if possible. Additionally, it is appreciated if faculty and staff members with other resources for travel available to them (grants, contracts, FUSE, PD) utilize those funds as effectively as possible.
