

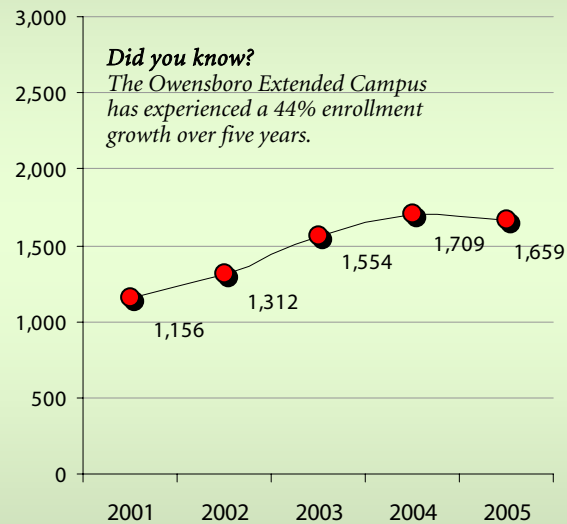
## About WKU's Owensboro Campus

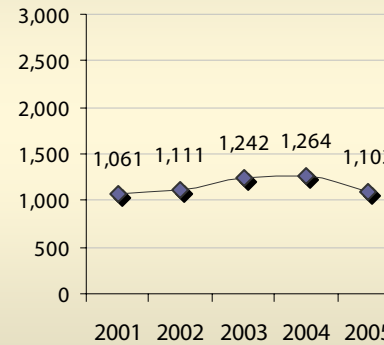

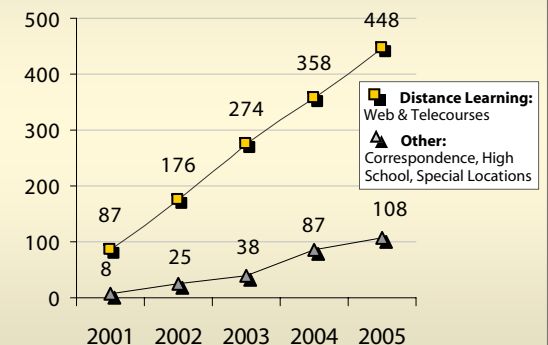
