## Steps to Earning a B.A. in History (#695)

- 1) Complete AA at any KCTCS institution  
Include: HIS 104,105,108, 109
- 2) Make application to WKU
- 3) Send all previous college transcripts to WKU Admissions Office
- 4) Meet with a WKU advisor each semester until 90 hours is earned and an Application for Graduation is on file with the Office of the Registrar
- 5) Follow suggested program of study below:  
Keep in mind:
  - take a minimum of 33 semester hours in History including HIS 104, 105, 108, 109 and 498
  - out of the remaining 18 hours a minimum of 15 must be upper division with one upper division coming from the following areas:
    - US History
    - European History to 1648
    - European History since 1648
    - Areas other than Europe or the US
  - Choose a minor or second major
  - Due to course availability, degree may not be able to be completed in 4 years

## OCTC – WKU General Education Requirements for History

### NOTE:

Completing either degree fulfills WKU's General Education requirements. (WKU-O offers courses that fulfill these requirements that could be used as well. These courses are listed below in **bold**.)
