1. Student will be enrolled in WKU classes in Owensboro (at least 6 hours undergraduate or 6 hours graduate) during each semester.
2. Student has a 3.0 grade point average on a 4.0 system.
3. Student has demonstrated outstanding citizenship qualities.
4. Student has completed an application for the scholarship and written the required informational statements, prior to April 1 deadline.
5. The scholarship is \$250 for fall semester and renewable for \$250 in spring semester, pending successful completion of fall semester.
