



Governor’s School for the Arts Scholarship Application

Western Kentucky University and the Office of Academic Affairs is pleased to offer scholarships to students that complete the Kentucky Governor’s School for the Arts summer program. **A complete application must be submitted to the Dean’s Office of Potter College of Arts & Letters by January 15th.** Incomplete applications will not be considered.

Scholarship applications cannot be considered unless an application for admission is on file. Applicants for GSA scholarships should submit the following:

- Completed Scholarship Application (this form) bearing the student’s signature and date of application.
- High School Transcript (This is in addition to the transcript you sent to the Office of Undergraduate Admissions.)
- A formal letter of interest and a resume.

*PLEASE NOTE:
If you are applying for an Art or Creative Writing scholarship, please include samples of your work. Art students may submit slides, photos, or originals. Music and Theatre & Dance students should schedule an audition with the appropriate department.*

A limited number of full and partial tuition scholarships will be offered to incoming freshmen who are GSA alumni with a GPA of 2.5+ AND an ACT composite score of 20+ (or SAT score of 930+). Awards are applied to the cost of in-state tuition.

Scholarship may be held for a total of eight semesters. Terms for renewal include maintaining good academic standing and enrollment in one of the following majors:

**Creative Writing - Music - Performing Arts
Theatre - Visual Arts**
