I. Definitions

Definition of F&A Costs:

F&A Costs, also known as indirect costs, are costs that are incurred for common or joint objectives and therefore cannot be identified readily and specifically with a particular sponsored project, an instructional activity, or any other institutional activity.

II. Policy

- 1. F&A funds represent reimbursement for real costs incurred by the University.
- 2. F&A funds will be required to the full extent allowed by the granting institution, and F&A funds shall not be waived in whole or in part without strong justification and the approval of the Associate Provost for Research as well as the affected college(s) and department(s).
- 3. Because F&A funds support research that is also supported by direct charges to grants, F&A distribution will follow the expenditure of direct costs, i.e., F&A distributions will not be made until the associated amount of direct expenditures have occurred.
- 4. Proposals to funding sources that do not allow F&A funds should consider the extent to which infrastructure costs may be chargeable as direct costs.
- 5. The distribution of F&A funds will balance the reimbursement of expended funds to support research, and the stimulation and incenting of new research.

III. Procedure for Administration of F&A Funds

- 1. F&A funds will be distributed from the Office of Research & Creative Activity to colleges in accordance with direct expenditures (see II.3 above).
- 2. Colleges shall be responsible for tracking distribution of F&A funds within colleges.

IV. Procedure for the Distribution of F&A Funds

- 1. The Office of Sponsored Programs will receive 19% to fund staffing and operations.
- 2. The Office of Research and Creative Activity will receive 43% for strategic research initiatives. This includes operating expenses associated with the protection and development of WKU-owned intellectual property such as salary, filing fees, legal fees, and other expenses associated with intellectual property and commercialization efforts.
- 3. The college of the P.I. will receive 38% unless an agreement to split F&A between colleges is made at the time of proposal submission. For example, the P.I. and a co-investigator may agree to allocate 75% of the 38% allocated to the college(s) to the P.I.'s college, and 25% of the 38% to the co-investigator's college.
- 4. Distribution of F&A funds within colleges shall be determined by the dean, who shall determine an appropriate fraction to be distributed to the head of the department(s) in which the F&A funds accrued.

V. Reason for Revision
