 MATH 116E if his/her: (1) MATH 096 grade was C; or (2) previous

 indicate need for enhanced version.]

The proposed prerequisites and special requirements have been a part of the Mathematics Department's placement procedures for nearly a decade. To clarify those procedures for students and advisors, we decided to add to the catalog description the criteria for placement in the enhanced version of College Algebra (MATH 116E).
