- 1. The committee began its review of the proposed Pedagogical Faculty Track during its October meeting. The committee hopes to make a recommendation to the Senate Executive Committee by the end of the fall term.
- 2. The committee is researching with college deans polices in place related to the completion of ABDs as a condition of employment.
- 3. The committee plans to review Faculty regent voting eligibility and if needed, make a recommendation to the Senate Executive Committee.
- 4. The committee is reviewing a draft policy for the creation of a standing committee for addressing Faculty Handbook updates and revisions.
- 5. The committee is drafting language for review by the Senate Executive Committee encouraging the university to achieve benchmarks with regard to employee health insurance contributions and to move to a variable contributions plan.
