Guidelines for the Ken and Melissa Dennison SKyTeach Scholarship

- 1. Recipients of the Ken and Melissa Dennison SKyTeach Scholarships are to be full-time students at Western Kentucky University and enrolled in the SKyTeach program.
- 3. First preference must be given to scholarships for participants of the SKyTeach Program who are graduates of Glasgow High School.
- 4. Recipients must have a minimum high school GPA of 3.0 or a minimum college cumulative GPA of 2.75.
- 5. Prior to receiving the scholarship, selected recipients must sign a Code of Conduct policy encompassing how they represent WKU and the SKyTeach Program.
- 6. If no student meets the above criteria, available funds may be used for the following areas of the SKyTeach Program:
  - a. Scholarships for participants of the SKyTeach Program who are graduates of Barren County or Grayson County schools.
  - b. Internships in Glasgow and Barren County and/or Grayson County.
  - b. Programming in middle and high school Math and Science classrooms in the Glasgow, Barren County, and/or Grayson County School District, conducted by SKyTeach participants. This programming will be continually reviewed and developed by the WKU SKyTeach representatives and representatives of the above named school districts.
