STUDENT TEACHING COURSE REGISTRATION

All prospective student teachers must register for 13 credit hours during their student teaching semester. (Selected students for international student teaching experiences will also be registered for a one credit hour Pass/Fail EDU 490 course by the Study Abroad Office.)

EDU 489, SPED 434, and SMED 489 are 3 hour student teaching seminar courses that will meet three (3) Fridays during the semester along with online activities and Saturday meetings. All meetings will be determined by the instructor.

Elementary Majors *require* 2 – 5-hour ELED 490 courses, 1 First Grade and 1 Fourth Grade.

<u>Middle Grade Majors</u> require 1 – 10 hour MGE 490 course for single certification or 2 – 5 hour MGE 490 courses for dual certification.

<u>Secondary Majors</u> require 1 – 10-hour SEC 490 in the certification subject area (major) as listed on the student teaching application.

FCS Majors require 2 – 5 hour courses, MGE 490 and SEC 490

AG, Business & Marketing, Foreign Language Majors require 1 – 10 hour SEC 490 in the certification subject area (major) as listed on the student teaching application.

Art, Music, & PE Majors require 2 – 5 hour courses for two student teaching assignments. Choose 1 ELED 490 and 1 SEC 490 for art, music and PE

Special Education Majors require 1 – 5-hour SPED 490 course and 1 – 5-hour ELED 490 course.

I.E.C.E. Majors require 2 – 5-hour IECE 490 courses.

Dual Majors require 2 – 5-hour 490 courses that correlate with the majors

The 490 courses (should equal 10 credit hours) are for your field experience and <u>DO NOT</u> require a course pass.
